GETTING STARTED

To participate in the CAC, the first step is for congressional offices to **sign up** on the website (under the “Congressional Offices” tab).

IEF will provide Congressional Offices with a toolkit that includes helpful resources, like sample social media posts, press releases, website content, and more. As soon as your office has decided to participate, you are invited to use these resources to begin reaching out to your district stakeholders.

Once the CAC launches in July, students will create and submit their own original apps (as individuals or in teams of up to four). IEF will handle the student registration, eligibility vetting, and final submission processes on behalf of offices. Throughout the Submission Period, it’s important for offices to encourage student participation through a variety of outreach efforts. Successful offices host launch events or hackathons, post regular reminders on social media, and stay in touch with teachers.
